2017/2018. Semester 1 (fall)

Application for Corvinus Students' Compensation Program scholarship based on academic achievement has been announced for the first (fall) semester of academic year 2017/2018.

Compensation Program scholarship based on educational achievement for Corvinus Students' is accessible to apply. In the NEPTUN study and registration system go to Administration /Requests Available and choose the "Corvinus Hallgatói Kompenzációs Program tanulmányi eredményen alapuló ösztöndíj pályázat 2017/2018/1" tab. You can apply by sending an application if you are engaged in a fee-paying program, started your full-time training not before September 2012 and paid the whole tuition fee in the first (fall) semester of academic year 2017/2018. In case of students who are continuing their studies in master programs (MA / MSc) after the Bachelor (BA / BSc), the master programs will be regarded to as a newly started education.

### **Eligibility requirements**

The two top decile of fee-paying students paid the whole tuition fee in the second (spring) semester of academic year 2017/2018, studying in full-time training, studying at the courses involved, who have reached the best stipend index in the semester prior – second (spring) semester of academic year 2016/2017– to the call of application will receive a scholarship.

Students are eligible, if they are continuously studying in an active status in the current (first, fall) semester of academic year 2017/2018) and in the previous (second, spring) semester of academic year 2016/2017) semester, are taking part in a fee-paying program, and paid the whole tuition fee in the first (fall) semester of academic year 2017/2018. It is also important that the tuition fee was paid by them or another private person, furthermore there is no exclusion against them.

### **Grounds for exclusion:**

Students who are not entitled in the first (fall) semester of academic year 2017/2018:

- a) Whose tuition fees were paid by another person, who required an invoice, or
- b) Who have regained their paid tuition fees in a form of another scholarship (e.g. MNB Scholarship),  
or
- c) Whose tuitions were in some form financed by the government (e.g. Stipentium Hungaricum)

### **Involved programs**

Programs that are concerned by this policy (hereinafter referred to as involved program) are those in which ratio of fee-paying students, who has paid the whole tuition fee in the first (fall) semester of academic year 2017/2018 and studying full-time training reach 60% in the total student population of the program in the first (fall) semester of academic year 2017/2018, and where the number of fee-paying students is at least 20.

The list of involved programs can be found on the website of the Student Welfare Committee (DJB, <http://djb.uni-corvinus.hu/>) and in Annex No. 1. of this invitation.

The basis for allocation of the Corvinus Students' Compensation Program scholarship based on academic achievement is in § 7 of the VOLUME III OF THE ORGANISATIONAL AND OPERATIONAL REGULATIONS STUDENT REQUIREMENTS III.2 Regulation on Student Fees and Benefits, which is

calculated in the same way as the stipend index. The ranking shows the calculated results of the stipend index of second (spring) semester of academic year 2016/2017.

$$\text{Stipend index} = \frac{\sum 1,2 \times \text{credit}^K \times \text{grade}^K + \sum \text{credit}^V \times \text{grade}^V}{\sum 1,2 \times \text{credit}^K + \sum \text{credit}^V}$$

where “K” means all mandatory and alternative subjects according to the recommended curriculum/operative curriculum as well as all subjects that are mandatory for the specialisation concerned “V” means optional subjects taken according to the recommended curriculum

Students will only receive a scholarship, if the courses they have accomplished in the second (spring) semester of academic year 2016/2017 are worth at least 24 credits. Scholarship may be granted only from a stipend index of 3,50. Corvinus Students' Compensation Program scholarship based on academic achievement will be allocated within the two top decile of fee-paying students, who has paid the whole tuition fee in the first (fall) semester of academic year 2017/2018 and studying full-time training in one of the involved programs.

The available budget is allocated in proportion to the stipend index among eligible students, but the students' allowance can not be higher than 50% of the full tuition of the first (fall) semester of academic year 2017/2018 based on Recruitment Information of Higher Education.

The detailed regulation is contained by VOLUME III OF THE ORGANISATIONAL AND OPERATIONAL REGULATIONS STUDENT REQUIREMENTS III.2.8 of the Corvinus Students' Compensation Program scholarships based on academic achievement.
